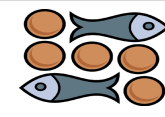

one by One Campaign
As we all know from our bulletin announcements, the one by One Campaign is underway here in our parish and throughout our diocese. At the heart of the campaign is a desire to transform communities by making strong parishes, growing priestly vocations, helping others discover Christ, and bringing Christ to those in need. Along with dynamic, committed priests, we need to support our Catholic schools, religious education programs and the families of our parish and diocesan communities. The overall goal for the diocese is \$70 million. The goal for St. Lawrence Parish is \$90,000. Of that St. Lawrence will receive back 50%, or \$45,000.00.
The projects that we plan to fund at St. Lawrence Parish with the portion we receive back include:
• Acoustic ceiling tile in the parish hall to help reduce noise.
• Televisions with DVD players and internet connections in our classrooms to support our religious education program.
• Improvements/upgrades to the rectory, parish hall and church, such as: painting, new flooring (especially in the rectory), new air conditioners (particularly in the church), and possibly a new furnace.
Some of the desired projects for the diocese include:
• Catholic Education: tuition assistance for students, improving school facilities, improving salaries to attract and retain good quality teachers and administrators, improving technology in the schools
• Vocation and Youth/Young Adult Ministry: improvements for Camp Tekakwitha, campus ministry, priestly vocations, help for senior priests
• Outreach Ministry: strengthening Catholic Charities especially in rural areas, help for rural parishes, homeless services
Once again, we are very grateful for those of you who have offered to be on our parish Campaign Leadership Committee (CLC). We will have a CLC meeting this Monday, 25 April, at 5:15 P.M. at St. Mary's Parish Hall. We are continuing to contact the members of our parish and inviting them to come to the parish office to see if they would like to make a gift to the one by One Campaign in order to help our parish achieve its goal. How much a person/couple/family wants to give and how they want to give it is entirely up to them, and the amount can be paid over a period of five years. Please know the parish will receive back 50% of whatever amount is raised, but hopefully with everyone's help, we can achieve our goal.
So far, we have received gifts totaling \$28,000.00. If you have visited with Fr. David and are considering making a gift, please feel free to contact him so that you can fill out your pledge card. All gifts to the one by One Campaign are fully tax deductible.
